## NBC News Video Collection Descriptions

### 'Starter Pack' Collection

One simple collection of 1,500 clips dating back to 1930 represents a sample of core curriculum subjects including U.S. history, government, global studies, health, biology, chemistry, physics, earth science, and language arts. This collection contains both archival and current material but not daily content updates.

### Social Studies

- U.S. History**  
 Bring U.S. History to life! Explore early American History with mini video-documentaries created by NBC News producers and leading historians, and access thousands of video resources from the earliest days of film and television to the present day, from the network that was there to record history as it happened.
- U.S. Government and Politics**  
 Help your students understand how Government and Politics affect their lives. Use real-world events, cases, and news stories to help students understand the Constitution, our system of government, and the people and events that have shaped our nation.
- Decision 2008**  
 Introduce your students to the candidates, the issues, and the political process in a secure environment built with education in mind.

- Global Studies**  
 The Global Studies collection includes engaging, relevant videos to support instruction

- Economics**  
 Explore real-world applications of both macro- and microeconomics in this collection of clips designed to help students understand how the forces of economics shape their world.

### Science

- Earth Sciences**  
 Earthquakes and volcanoes. Oceans and landforms. Weather patterns and meteorology. Explore the forces that shape our world with this collection of videos for earth science teachers.
- Astronomy and Space Science**  
 From the history of the space race to the latest discoveries in cosmology, this collection introduces students to the wonders of our solar system and universe, and to the people and innovations that have helped us explore them.
- Life Sciences and Biology**  
 Our understanding of genetics, biodiversity, ecology, and other topics in biology and life science is evolving rapidly. Show students real-world applications of these developments in medicine, environmental protection, paleontology, and other fields.
- Physical Sciences, Chemistry, and Physics**  
 Introduce your students to real-world applications of the principals of physics and chemistry, including energy, forces, chemical bonding, machines and work, and more.
- Environmental Science**  
 This collection allows students to visit habitats around the world and explore the latest research in environmental science, including the debate on climate change, energy use, and human impact on the environment.
- Forensic Science**  
 Explore DNA testing, ballistics, fingerprinting, arson investigation, and more in this special collection of cross-curricular resources designed to show students real world applications of scientific principals.

### Language Arts

Examine different writing styles and types. Explore the power of words by studying famous speeches and examples of powerful writing. Hear authors talk about the writing process in their own words. This collection of video, text, and image resources has been designed to give English teachers tools they need to make writing engaging and relevant for today's generation. Plus, find a library of provocative video prompts designed to promote debate on subjects important in teenagers' lives.
